BASKET BUDDIES FAQ'S



Sydney Basket Brigade

Do I need to find a box or basket for my items?

Yes please! Ideally we'd like you to find a box with a lid, but a basket would work well too. If you have any difficulties finding one, just let us know and we'll track one down for you.



Can I decorate my box or basket?

Absolutely! We'd love you to make your box look as festive as you can, whether this is by using gift wrap, arts and crafts or stickers. Don't worry if you're unable to decorate your box though – we're teaming up with some of our local schools who are going to provide us with some pictures that we can stick on our boxes too.

Should I seal my box after I have collected all my items?

No, please don't seal your box just in case any extra items are donated that we can add to your basket on Packing Day.

What should I keep in mind when purchasing my items?

Please make sure that the expiry date is minimum February 2018, and that you avoid dented or rusty cans.



Can I substitute items on the shopping list?

We'd really like you to try and find all the goodies on our shopping list for your basket, but if you're unable to find an item and need to substitute it for another one then please do.

Can I add other items to my basket too?

Of course you can! Any extra food, personal products, confectionary, gifts and Christmas decorations are always very gratefully received too.

Do I need to include a Christmas card, and can I make my own?

Yes please! We aim to include a Christmas card in each of our baskets. You can either design your own, find your own, or print and decorate the Christmas card we've attached to this email. Please note that cards must not be in an envelope and must not be religious. We ask that your card only includes the following message inside:

This comes from someone who cares about you. All we ask is that you take care of yourself well enough to be able to do this for someone else some day.

Do I need to add a gift to my basket and if so, should I wrap it up?

We would love you to include an unwrapped gift in your basket if you can – however big or small, and for any age.

What shall I do with my basket once I have collected all of my items?

Drop off your goodies at your nearest collection point. Keep an eye out for our emails with the dates and locations of the collection points which will be announced at the beginning of November. All baskets will be delivered to nominated recipients on Packing Day. If you can't get to a collection point, send us an email and we'll try to sort something out.

When is Packing Day and how can I register?

Packing Day is on Saturday, 16 December 2017. Registration will open in early November and we will ensure that our Basket Buddies are the first to know.

Do you need any other volunteers?
